The entry fee this year will be \$650, plus an additional \$50 going towards the prize pool, for a total of \$700 CAD. ## GOLF



This year we are returning to The Revere Golf Club in Henderson, Nevada. Feedback from previous years has always been positive and we are once again confident that everyone will find this facility will meet or exceed one's expectations. Information on The Revere Golf Club can be found on their website [www.reveregolf.com](http://www.reveregolf.com). The Revere Golf Club has two 18 hole courses and we will be playing both courses. On Day 1 we will play The Lexington course and on Day 2 we will play The Concord course. The course has the appearance of TPC Scottsdale course in Phoenix which hosts the Waste Management Open each year on the PGA Tour. The Revere Golf Club offers excellent golf course conditions and playability that is suited to both the frequent and occasional golfer. There are also fantastic views of the Las Vegas Strip and we will once again be providing transportation to the course and back to the hotel as part of the entry fee.

## HOTEL



We will once again be staying at The Planet Hollywood Hotel and Casino. This location has proven to be popular given its central location on the Las Vegas Strip. Scheduled check in is at 1600 and final check out is at 1100. In addition to the excellent views of either the Strip or surrounding mountains, we have negotiated the following property benefits:

- ~ upgraded Strip views (based on availability at check in)
- ~ no fee early check in (based on availability at check in)
- ~ in room internet access (2 device maximum)
- ~ daily access to the resort fitness center (not including the spa) 2 guests

As well, we were able to negotiate tournament pricing for the Sunday and Monday before the tournament as well as the Friday after the tournament. Please note there are a limited number of rooms available these days. If you are interested, please make your request early as we are required to release our inventory one month prior to the tournament. The price for each additional night is \$190 CAD per night (single or double occupancy) and priority will be based in the order we receive your request. If you prefer your own room, the single supplement is an additional \$300 for the 3 nights of the tournament (Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday).

The tournament officially kicks off Tuesday November 8th with our open bar social from 1900-2100 hrs.

The Golf Tournament starts with the bus leaving The Planet Hollywood Hotel at 0700 sharp! A 0900 shotgun start has been planned on both days. Day 1 (Wednesday) will be an individual stroke play event and scoring will be done with the Callaway Handicap System.

Day 2 (Thursday) will once again be the popular team event (scramble format). Our Goal is to leave the course by 1530 on Wednesday and 1630 on Thursday. This will leave everyone with ample time to get back to the hotel and enjoy a few bevys, get cleaned up and still be able to go out and enjoy all that the Las Vegas Strip has to offer.
